College Place is a community of love and faith, training and nurturing disciples of Jesus Christ, equipping them with God's Word, and spreading His redeeming love to every soul in need.

**Forward in Faith – Outward in Hope  
Building Campaign Update**

It's exciting to look back and see how far the Lord has led College Place. The original project, begun six years ago, included the construction of the Christian Life Center and the creation of new offices, additional classrooms, and a new kitchen at the cost of \$1.2 million. The Church had been able to accumulate \$200,000 dollars before we began our "Building the Legacy" Campaign. At the end of the first three-year capital campaign, we were left with a debt of around \$635,500. That's when we launched our "Forward in Faith, Outward in Hope" Campaign. The title of this second three-year capital campaign expressed our desire to move forward in two ways: to make the most of our location with a few additional building projects, and to pay off our building loan so we can move forward into the future debt-free. All construction, including the new parking area, electronic sign, and new landscaping has been completed at the cost of \$237,169. Meanwhile, we have continued to pay down our debt. Due to careful cost control, we were able to pay an additional \$60,000 in April against our outstanding debt, reducing the amount owed to \$293,500. We are in the final months of our 2005 "Forward in Faith, Outward in Hope" Capital Fund Campaign. Based on the amounts pledged in 2005 and received to date, full payment of our mortgage this year is within reach. We want to encourage those who pledged to fulfill their commitment by November. If you have fallen behind on your pledge, we would encourage you to get caught up so that we can complete the program by November. As is often the case, we have lost members due to deaths, moves, and other reasons. Those who have not had the opportunity to contribute to this campaign have the opportunity to help replace the contributions we will not receive. We have the opportunity to move forward in faith without debt. We hope that all in the College Place family will give your prayerful attention to this. As always, we thank you for your continued support of this campaign.

**"Seminar on the Mount" Series Starts Sunday**

Beginning this Sunday, June 1, I will be preaching through the Sermon on the Mount contained in Matthew's gospel, chapters five through seven. Jesus held an outdoor seminar on a hillside recruiting and training followers for his "Kingdom of God" movement. ## Local & Connectional Missions

United Methodist Council on Relief (UMCOR) Disaster Relief teams continue to be needed in Bibb County (Macon), especially the Lizzella community. As of Saturday, May 24, 2008 thirty-eight (38) intakes or requests for help have been received by the UMCOR Disaster Relief coordination center temporarily located at the Lizzella United Methodist Church on Rt 80, approximately 5 miles west of I-475. Samaritan's Purse reportedly has more than 300 requests for assistance. Help is needed removing downed trees, and temporarily covering roofs with tarp. Recent thunderstorms have exacerbated the problem by damaging temporary repairs that were made immediately following the tornados on Mother's Day which damaged or completely destroyed an estimated 1000 homes. I will be taking a team to Lizzella again on June 7. Volunteers interested in going should contact me, Billy Zeh, Local & Connectional Missions Chair, College Place UMC at 912-996-3468 or 912-265-0121. Volunteers should bring chain saws, mixed fuel, hand and pruning saws, heavy duty pruning shears, hammers, a tape measure, a knife, gloves, and a smile. Materials for roof repairs are provided. If you have them, pick up trucks and open bed trailers are a blessing. Water and lunch will be provided. Frosty's from Wendy's on the way home are an option! We will leave College Place UMC on Saturday June 7 at 6:00 am and will arrive back in Brunswick no later than 9:00 pm Saturday night.
