College Place is a community of love and faith, training and nurturing disciples of Jesus Christ, equipping them with God's Word, and spreading His redeeming love to every soul in need.

The Spiritual Gifts in Our Church

Thanks to each of you who took the time to complete a Spiritual Gifts Survey. At last count, we had 129 survey reports turned in. What a wonderful response to God's invitation to recognize and celebrate the gifts he has given to each of us! Some of us were not surprised at the results of our survey, and had confirmed for us what we already suspected. Some of us may have been surprised at first, then pleased to learn that God has blessed us in a way we didn't suspect. Regardless of the results, we hope that we have each learned something about ourselves that will help us in our service to Christ.

Based on each member's top response, our church is extremely blessed with members who have the spiritual gift of **Faith (21), Giving (21), or Service/Helps (21)**. The next tier is made up of those whose top gift is either **Administration (13), Mercy (11), Hospitality (9), or Teaching (8)**. Another tier includes those with the gift of **Discernment (5), Knowledge (5), Exhortation (2), Prophecy (2), or Leadership (1)**.

If you include the top three gifts of each participant, all sixteen spiritual gifts which were surveyed are represented in our congregation. When you include the top three gifts of members, the most frequent gifts occurring are still **Faith (58), Giving (59), and Service/Helps (59)**. Next are **Administration (36), Mercy (35) and Knowledge (29)**. Next are **Hospitality (21), Teaching (19) and Discernment (17)**. The remaining Spiritual Gifts and the number of times they appear among the three top gifts are **Exhortation (11), Leadership (9), Wisdom (4), Evangelism (3), Prophecy (2), Apostleship (1) and Shepherding (1)**.

We invite anyone who has not yet completed a Spiritual Gift Survey to do so. The Lay Leadership Committee will use the information revealed through the surveys as they prepare to invite members to serve in the various positions of leadership and service in our church during 2009. We will use another kind of survey in the Fall to give our members an opportunity to identify the areas of ministry in which you would be interested in serving. However, don't wait if you feel God is calling you to serve. We hope your service will take on new meaning as you serve through the empowerment of God in a ministry that is important to you.
