**We Have Been Blessed by You**

Kay and I want to thank you, our church family, for the calls, cards, and expressions of sympathy you have given us since Kay's mother died. It has been a difficult time for Kay and her four siblings, but we have felt supported by your care and concern. We have renewed appreciation for the love of Christ shared, and made real, through the Body of Christ. In addition to the many cards we have received from you, we have received almost 50 e-mails from my fellow clergy and laypeople throughout the "connection" of the United Methodist Church. For those who are new to Methodism, "connectionalism" may be an unfamiliar word. It refers to the fact that each United Methodist congregation is related to every other United Methodist congregation. We share together in mission and ministry in so many ways. Since the beginning of the Methodist movement, John Wesley called together the leaders and members of the movement into Conferences to be led and encouraged *together*. "Connection" is about cooperation, collective discernment, and togetherness. Other denominations brag about being autonomous churches, we brag about being connectional. Kay and I can certainly testify to the fact that the "connection" has been a source of support and comfort for us in the last couple of weeks. I received cell phone calls from my clergy fishing buddies who have become brothers to me. There were half a dozen clergy present at the funeral who did not know Kay's mother, but they knew us, and were there to support us. (And that was on a Sunday at 2:00 which didn't make it easy for ministers to come.) We also had representatives from College Place and some of Kay's co-workers present. To show we care is not complicated, because showing up, or sending a card, or saying, "I am praying for you" has meant the world to us. Another reason, I am glad we are a connectional church is that I have a Superintendent. Rev. Marcia Cochran represents the connection in many ways. I could call Marcia on Friday and ask her to preach for me on Sunday. Marcia visited me in my office the Tuesday after the funeral. We spoke of what it's like to lose two parents. I am fortunate to have both of my parents still living, but Kay now has lost both her parents (her father died in 2004). Donna Bazemore, our children's director, with the death of her father a couple of weeks ago, has now lost both her parents. When Marcia's parents died within a couple of years of each other, she said that the minister who preached her mother's funeral shared what Jesus once said to his disciples. Jesus said, "I will not leave you orphaned." Marcia told me how the words had new meaning for her, because she realized at that moment she was an orphan in one sense. Jesus told his disciples that they would not be orphaned though because he was sending his Spirit to be with them and among them and in them. The Spirit of Christ accompanies us in a thousand ways – both inwardly within our spirits, and outwardly through the Body of Christ. We are so thankful for the Spirit of Christ and the Body of Christ for us, and for all of you who are dealing with the loss of loved ones. The Lord bless you.
