Our New Bishop, Bishop James King

Last week, delegates from the South Georgia Conference attended our Southeastern Jurisdictional Conference at the Conference Center at Lake Junaluska, NC. Delegates from the southeastern United States meet every four years (the same year as the General Conference for the denomination) to coordinate mission and ministry for the region and to elect and assign bishops for the region. There was only one opening for the election of a new bishop this time, but a number of bishops had fulfilled their term limits and were therefore up for reassignment to another area. Our bishop, Michael Watson, was one of those bishops up for reassignment, and he is going to the North Georgia Conference to serve as their bishop. That means a new bishop has been assigned to our area. Our new bishop, Bishop James King, has been serving as the Bishop of the Kentucky Conference. He recently preached at our 2008 Annual Conference in Columbus. His preaching made a very good first impression on me. He and his wife, Rose, will be moving to Macon at the first of September. In the weeks ahead, our District Superintendent, Rev. Marcia Cochran, will be letting us know of the dates for when there will be a conference "welcome" and also when he will be visiting the Waycross District. In the meantime, we are encouraged to write the Kings and welcome them to South GA and the Waycross District. His address is: 7400 Floydsburg Road, Crestwood, KY 40014. DID you know...?

Each year 310,000 Americans die of heart attacks before they can receive lifesaving medical treatment. At College Place, thanks to a very generous donation from a family in our church, we are in the process of purchasing two Automatic External Defibrillators (AED's) to be used in the event of a cardiac emergency. When an AED is used in conjunction with Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) within 3 minutes of the onset of symptoms, survival rates jump from 7% to 70%.

While simple to use, AED's are only effective if we have trained responders available. If you are currently certified please let Trudy know so that we can add your name to the list of trained responders. If you would like to become certified we will be running American Red Cross classes over the next several months. The basic CPR/AED Class takes 4 hours to complete. There is a companion 4 hour First Aid Class that, while not needed to treat cardiac emergencies, is recommended. The only cost for attending each class is the \$7.00 certification fee that the Red Cross charges.

Anyone interested in being trained is welcome to enroll. It is important that the church staff, ushers, teachers, etc. become trained. Each class is limited to 10 participants so sign up early. Call the Church Office at 265-4883 to enroll. If you have questions, please call me at 262-1126.

June Financial Update

Through June, (the mid point of the year), we are pleased to report that the congregation has given \$267,781 on projected receipts of \$253,040. Expenses have totaled \$250,412 on a budget of \$251,320. It is wonderful to see how everyone has pulled together to control expenses. We currently have \$31,118 in our checking account (about half is designated giving). On June 27, 2008, an additional \$25,000 was applied against the building mortgage reducing our loan balance to \$262,300.

During the summer months, as people vacation, church giving traditionally tapers off. Yet, the needs of the church go on. Please make an effort to stay current on your pledge. Your support is so important!
