**Hospitality: Our Core Practice
In a Community of Love and Faith**

Our vision statement says: *College Place is a community of love and faith, training and nurturing disciples of Jesus Christ, equipping them with God's Word, and spreading his redeeming love to every soul in need.* In the coming weeks, we will be talking about the practice of hospitality as a "core practice" of the church, especially a church that strives to be a community of love and faith. We will be looking at this practice from many different angles. We learn today that hospitality is very much a biblical practice that is central to the life of God's people. It serves many purposes in our life together – as we relate *internally* with one another and relate *externally* to those who come our way.

One emphasis in this series is how we can show hospitality every day. It is one important way we live our faith in our everyday lives in our everyday world. One temptation is to compartmentalize our faith into a "box" we call "church." However, our faith is either expressed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, or it's not *authentically* expressed at all.

Another emphasis is how we, as a church, plan to form a bridge between home and church through the *Neighborhood Group Program*. We are grouping our congregation according to neighborhoods to promote mutual care among members in a comprehensive fashion and to promote outreach to members' neighbors. We will follow up on our neighbors whom we haven't seen. We will gather together for a meal and fellowship at least quarterly (more often if desired). At gatherings we will have a brief devotional, share concerns, sign cards, and send them to people in need. We will report to the church office any births, incidents of joy, sickness, death, and other experiences. We will welcome newcomers into the neighborhood and invite neighbors (new or old) to church and/or neighborhood gatherings. Please begin praying for the role God would have you play in becoming a more caring church. Stay tuned for more information...

I think we all have experienced hospitality before. I think most of us have probably shown hospitality. Many in our congregation have the spiritual gift of hospitality. Be open over the next couple of months to expanding this concept and this practice in your life.

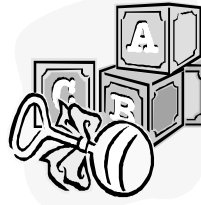

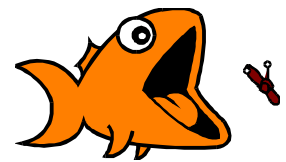
