The Beginning of Lent

We begin the season of Lent on Ash Wednesday by remembering that we are dust and to dust we shall return. In other words, we remember our need for a Savior. Lent prepares us to take in the meaning of Christ's sacrifice on the cross and the victory of self-giving love over death proclaimed on Easter. Lent is therefore a time when we stress self-sacrifice, not as a means of earning God's love, but to remember that the love, which He gives so freely, was very costly to Him. We also remember during this season that He wants us to take up our cross and follow him by serving our fellow man. Come join us in order to make a good beginning for this season of preparation.

The Season of Lent

The season of Lent is a period of 40 days from Ash Wednesday to Easter (not counting Sundays). In the same way that Jesus began his ministry after a 40-day period of fasting and testing, we also take time to prepare to celebrate the meaning of the cross and the empty tomb of Jesus Christ.

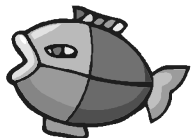
