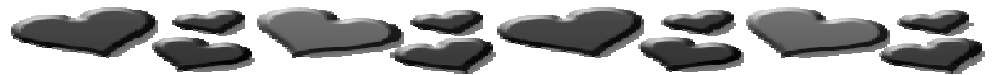
College Place is a community of love and faith, training and nurturing disciples of Jesus Christ, equipping them with God's Word, and spreading His redeeming love to every soul in need.

On February 15 Dr. Edwin Chase from The Methodist Home will be at College Place preaching at both services. Edwin is a pastoral counselor who serves as senior chaplain and director of the Family Institute at the Methodist Children's Home in Macon, Georgia. Prior to coming to the Home, he served as director of the Clergy Resource Center, which he founded at the Pastoral Institute in Columbus, Georgia. Prior to that, he served for 14 years as a parish minister in Americus and Savannah. He is married to Carole and has three sons and three grandchildren. He is also a great friend and mentor to Jay and a group of seven preachers who get together regularly to support each other and fish together.

Edwin's sermon topic will be "In the Worst of Times, God Does the Best of Things." His sermon illustrations will be drawn primarily from *Patches of the Quilt: True Stories from a Children's Home*, a book, recently published and written by a group of adults who grew up at The Methodist Home. As one of those adults, Dr. Chase has his own stories to tell of God's goodness in unexpected places. The entire morning will be a celebration of the goodness of God and how that goodness shines its brightest through the church's ministry to "the least of these." In the worst of times God often does the best of things. But we must have eyes of faith to see it.

For those who wish to purchase a copy of *Patches of the Quilt*, a table will be set up, and you can "meet the author" and have Dr. Chase sign your copy.

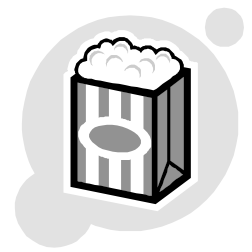
