What can we do?

On Jan. 12 Haiti was rocked with a 7.0 magnitude earthquake. Haiti is the most impoverished nation in the western hemisphere. While nations rush to assist with supplies and medical aid many of us are wanting to do something to help. Here are some suggestions: 1) Pray. When you think you have prayed enough for Haiti...pray some more. 2) Donate financially. There are many great humanitarian aid non-profit organizations that are helping with the Haiti relief. Choose wisely. 3) UMCOR (United Methodist Committee On Relief) is our choice for relief organizations. While other non-profits use portions of the donations for staff salaries, UMCOR's staff is paid directly from their annual budget. All UMC's give to UMCOR. This is one of our "apportionment" items all churches contribute annually. The Haiti relief is part of the UMCOR advance giving #418325. 4) Help with "Health Kits." UMCOR sends items packaged as health kits in times of disasters. The items include a hand towel, a wash cloth, a bar of soap, a comb, a nail file or fingernail clippers, a toothbrush (single, in original sealed wrapper), 6 adhesive plastic strip sterile bandages and a \$1.00 bill to help purchase toothpaste. The toothpaste is bought separately due to expiration dates in relation to the kits being sent out. The word is spreading about the Health Kits. Help spread the word. I am in hopes we at College Place and the Brunswick area can collect as many as possible before Jan. 31. We will deliver what ever we have to Sager Brown in Baldwin, Louisiana.
