Holy Week (April 5 - 12)

Not only will we hear about the problem, but we will also hear about the remedy in the cross of Jesus Christ. Come join this Lenten journey.

Good Friday Tenebrae Service featuring Special Music by the Chancel Choir (April 10) - At 7:00pm, we will gather in the sanctuary for a Good Friday Tenebrae Service. Tenebrae means "shadows." Through candles and shadows, readings and music, we will take a journey together through Christ's passion. In this way, we will understand the means of our redemption and the depth of Christ's love for us.
