"Time to Talk to Yourself"

Graduation will soon be here. These are exciting, much anticipated days for our high school seniors and their families.

In the weeks ahead the graduates will hear baccalaureate sermons and commencement speeches that will encourage them to give of their best and to live meaningful lives. But sermons and speeches don't amount to anything unless we are ready to listen and really hear what is being said. When we are offered encouragement we are usually quick to think more about our limitations and less about our potential. We convince ourselves that we are inadequate and unable. We decide that we can't do something before we even try.

It is time to change the way we talk to ourselves. Rather than put ourselves down with all the reasons we can't, it's time to focus more on all the ways we can. The following are some examples of positive self-talk:

*- Keep It Simple - First Things First - Make Each Day Count
- Don't Sweat the Small Stuff - God Loves Me*

You can probably think of many more examples to add to the list. What's important to remember is that you have the power to control how you feel and how others try to make you feel about yourself. When you consistently belittle yourself or give others the power to make you think you're something less than a child of God, it can become a powerful and destructive force in you, your families, and all of your relationships. Remember the scripture that says, ***"Whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable...think about such things."*** (Philippians 4:8)

My hope is that each graduate, and each one of you, will take the time to talk to yourself and allow yourself to hear, to really hear, and believe how special you are. Open your eyes to see God's blessings that we often take for granted; open your ears to listen to the encouragement we receive from others; and open your hearts to respond to God's love and his hope-filled direction for our lives.

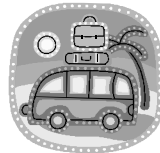
