Celebrating Pentecost and Confirmation

This Sunday, we are celebrating two events. Pentecost is our annual commemoration of the day the Holy Spirit descended upon the followers of Jesus who had gathered for the festival in Jerusalem. Ten days earlier they had watched their risen Savior Jesus ascend into heaven leaving behind the promise that the Holy Spirit would soon come. They were told to wait with expectant hearts. When the Holy Spirit did come on the day of Pentecost there were amazing sights and sounds: the sound of a mighty wind, flames resting on the disciples, the once fumbling disciples now preaching boldly, and three thousand new believers being baptized. The gift of the Holy Spirit is seen as the catalyst that brought the Church into being – ordinary people infused with the Spirit, the power, and the life of the risen Christ – to be the hands and feet and face of Christ in the world.

What a fitting day for our young people to make their public profession of faith in Christ. They have been mentored over the course of the last several months. They have read the bible, learned about being a disciple of Jesus Christ, and written down their understandings in a journal. They are saying “yes” to the Lord and the relationship He offers. We will lay hands on them to symbolize the Holy Spirit being poured upon them to incorporate them into the Body of Christ and empower them for service in God’s kingdom. In witnessing what happens to them, we bring to culmination all the messages we’ve been hearing since Easter about the salvation Christ offers. May their confirmation inspire us to live more fully into what it means to be saved.

Our confirmands will be introduced at the end of the 8:45 service and brought into the life of the church in the 11:00 service.
